



## NSW STATE TEAM PLAYERS CODE OF CONDUCT

Attendance at all training sessions both on and off the ice is compulsory unless an acceptable excuse is provided to either the Team Manager, or the Coach, prior to training sessions. Failure to do so may result in exclusion from the Team.

While travelling and participating as a member of the team:

1. All team members are required to be dressed in a neat and tidy manner at all times, and wear team uniforms when required.
2. All team members will be required to behave in a manner deemed appropriate as a representative of New South Wales.
3. If under the legal age, proven possession of and / or consumption of alcohol and tobacco products will not be tolerated.
4. Proven possession of and / or consumption of illegal substances will not be tolerated.
5. Interfering with another team member or a team member's personal effects will not be tolerated.
6. Any behaviour on or off the ice considered as bringing Ice Hockey NSW into disrepute, or as being disruptive to the team, will not be tolerated.

Any player / official found to have contravened the above code of conduct may be sent home. Prior to this action being taken, the player's parents or guardian will be notified to allow the player to make appropriate arrangements. The player, parent or guardian will meet any expenses incurred by sending a player home. No prior payments / money paid, will be refunded.

A report of any breach of the Code of Conduct will be given to the Ice Hockey NSW Committee of Management to deal with as they think fit.
